





Overview

Overall, UNCTs in the Africa made progress:

scores improved from 30% (2021) to 33% (2022) scores decreased from 33% (2021) to 29% (2022)



- 89% (47 of 53) of UNCTs supported investments in youth-led solutions, 81% (38 of 47) of these UNCTs carried out such investments WITH youth.
- 64% (34 of 53) of UNCTs included youth in joint communication and advocacy plans; 91% (31 of 34) of these UNCTs activated campaigns WITH youth.
- 53% (28 of 53) of UNCTs included youth components in their knowledge-exchange plans; 75% (21 of 28) of these UNCTs carried out the knowledge-exchange activities WITH youth.

scores improved from 38% (2021) to 39% (2022)

scores decreased from 37% (2021) to 30% (2022)

- 38% (20 of 53) saw no change
- 26% (14 of 53) fell behind

- 83% (5 of 6) made progress





Insights by KPI (2022):

- 96% (51 of 53) of UNCTs included results for youth in United Nations Sustainable Development Cooperation Framework (UNSDCFs); 90% (46 of 51) of UNCTs were backed by a youth situational analysis.
- 92% (49 of 53) of UNCTs included Youth2030 programme priorities in their joint workplans.
- 85% (45 of 53) of UNCTs included details on joint programming on youth in publicly available annual reports.
- 55% (29 of 53) of UNCTs had information on funding (planned, available or utilized) on youth.
- 26% (14 of 53) of UNCTs included Youth2030 priorities in their Business Operations Strategy (BOS) implementation plans.
- UNCTs designed and implemented their UNSDCFs together WITH vouth:
 - 89% (47 of 53) UNCTs included youth situational analysis in the UN Common Country Analysis (CCA), 68% (32 of 47) of the CCAs were done WITH youth.
 - · 96% (51 of 53) UNCTs included results for youth in UNSDCF, 59% (30 of 53) of Cooperation Frameworks (CFs) were done WITH youth.

scores decreased from 30% (2021) to 28% (2022) scores increased at 46% (2021) to 47% (2022)



- 57% (30 of 53) of UNCTs were coordinated through a results group/ thematic group/task team for joint action on youth.
- 17% (9 of 53) UNCTs included actions to strengthen internships; 21% (11 of 53) included actions to improve the proportion of youth in their workforce.
- 25% (13 of 53) of UNCTs engaged all 4 categories of youth (groups); networks of youth, both formal and informal were most frequently engaged 89% (47 of 53) of UNCTs.
- Networks of youth engaged by UNCTs:

 Girls and young women 	70% (37 of 53)
 Youth at grassroots level 	74% (39 of 53)
 Youth with disabilities 	57% (30 of 53)
 Migrant youth 	40% (21 of 53)
• LGBTIQ+	26% (14 of 53)

 Youth living with HIV 	45% (24 of 53)
 Youth in conflict – affected areas 	28% (15 of 53)


